

Student Admission to the English -Language Master's Program "Logistics and Supply Chain Management" Department of Economics Academic Year 2025-2026

The Department of Economics at the School of Economics and Political Sciences, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, is pleased to announce the launch of its English-language Master's Program in "Logistics & Supply Chain Management" for the 2025–2026 academic year. Successful graduates will be awarded a Master of Science (MSc) degree.

The program is designed for graduates from departments such as Business Administration, Economics, Sciences, Computer Science, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering, and related fields from universities in Greece or internationally recognized institutions. Graduates from relevant disciplines, as well as professionals with experience in logistics, supply chain management, or related sectors, are also encouraged to apply.

The program spans three semesters: two semesters of coursework followed by one semester dedicated to independent research, culminating in the submission of a Master's dissertation.

Tuition Fees: 5.000 Euros

Applicants must submit their application along with the required and any additional supporting documents electronically via the link: <u>https://eforms.auth.gr/aithsh-eis-pms-log-2025/</u>.

Applications can be submitted from May 1, 2025, to June 15, 2025.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- 1. Application (to be filled out on the Master's website).
- 2. Curriculum Vitae.
- 3. Copy of degree or diploma (with equivalence and recognition certificate from NARIC¹ if the degree is from abroad).
- 4. Transcript of undergraduate or postgraduate studies (if applicable).
- 5. Two (2) recommendation letters (one academic).
- 6. English language proficiency at level (C2/G2/CPE).
- 7. Scientific publications, honors (if applicable).
- 8. Certificates of work experience (if applicable).
- 9. Copy of ID or Passport.

¹ If the degree has been awarded by a foreign institution, in order to be recognized, the following conditions must be met: i) The awarding institution must be included in the list of foreign institutions maintained and updated by the Hellenic NARIC (DOATAP): **"National Registry of Recognized Higher Education Institutions Abroad"**:

10. Recent Photograph.

Evaluation Criteria:

1. Academic Performance (40%)

 Evaluation based on the overall degree grade, the type of degree obtained, and/or the candidate's ranking among their peers.

Personal Interview (10%)

 Assessment of communication skills, motivation, and suitability for the program during a personal interview.

3. Professional Experience (20%)

 Consideration of relevant work experience in logistics, supply chain management, or related fields.

4. Research and Academic Activities (20%)

 Includes prior research experience, academic publications, and completed postgraduate studies.

5. Other Qualifications (10%)

 Evaluation of additional credentials such as GMAT scores, extra degrees or postgraduate diplomas, proficiency in additional foreign languages, participation in seminars, and related achievements.
